

F Class Training Weekend October 5th and 6th. Trentham Rifle Range.

Meet at the Provincial Club rooms on the Trentham range at 9am Saturday.

For those out of town, the Provincial Clubrooms have about 10 beds available, you will need a sleeping bag, if you want to stay on site. Cost is \$10 per night. Bring your breakfast.

Those staying on site will start earlier, probably by 8am, doing the range preparation such as flags up and targets out. If you can be there early to help that would be good.

You will probably need about 100 rounds for the weekend. We will not be shooting for scores, only groups and technique work, so the amount you want to use is up to you.

We will be shooting with the Wellington Clubs on Saturday afternoon so will have to spread ourselves around to accommodate. We are using the Petone targets during the rest of the weekend. The clubs have a range fee for their shooting and you will be paying direct to them for the Saturday afternoon.

We are using electronic targets so bring a tablet or whatever you use if you want to save shoots.

Weather permitting, I hope we can spend most of our shooting time at 1000 yards.

I will do my best with the weather but no promises.

Gazebos are available so even if it is wet, within reason, we should still be able to shoot.

I will get some lunch food organised. It will be bread or buns and something to put in them, or bring your own if you want.

There will be a cost for range and target use, and the lunches. Not sure how much yet but will be less than \$50.

Saturday evening will be a meal at a local eatery for those that want too, own cost.

The weekend is for learning, improving, sharing, and fun with like minded shooters.
