With South Island facing another scorcher, the main challenge was hot and sticky conditions. Les Grimsey and Chris Kershaw were on fire as they started out with 60s and 50s in the opening two ranges with high centre counts. Nobody else scored a possible.

The target rifle leader-board changed in the afternoon with Bruce Horwood registering 99 ex 100 to win the Eastern Southland Aggregate (with a score of 196.23) by 3 Vs from Chris Kershaw, with Daniel Alexander a further 5 Vs behind. The F Class was led by Les Grimsey, followed by Phil Gardener (top F-TR) and Geoff Smith (top F-TRC).

Day 2 proved to be cooler with a fickler wind than the opening day of the Southland Aggregate and scoring was highly competitive. Over half of the TR field scored 100 ex 100 in the opening two ranges, including double possibles from John Miller and Ken Chittock who kept pressure on the top three. The F-Class shooters were also scoring highly.



Going into the final 600, Les Grimsey was only 2 points down after 5 ranges in F-Open. TR was proving interesting with Bruce Horwood and Daniel Alexander just 4 points down in Class B and A respectively, closely followed by Chris Kershaw.

Les closed out with a 59, Chris conjured up a 49 to take the TR Championship.
